We require all participants, both children and adults, to participate with a positive attitude and an inclusive spirit. We embrace every participant, regardless of ability, experience, size or gender. Anything less will not be tolerated by our club, our coaches or our other families. Any type of bullying, profanity or harassment is unacceptable and may result in immediate removal from the playing field.

- 1.) Understand and value the loyalty and commitment of adults and teammates.
- 2.) Inform a coach, adult or club official of any unacceptable treatment/abuse.
- 3.) Set a good example by recognizing fair play and applauding the good performances of all.
- 4.) Encourage all players and do not enter into any type of abuse/ bullying either on the pitch or off the pitch.
- 5.) Use correct and proper language at all times; no swearing.
- 6.) Be a sportsman. Win with dignity and lose with grace.
- 7.) Encourage players to always play by the rules.
- 8.) Recognize the value and importance of volunteer coaches. They give of their time and resources to provide recreational activity for your child. Help them out whenever and wherever you can.
